Unit 3.3: Create a Secret Board

You should now be looking at the Pinterest page that will open after you have logged in and created your profile.

It is time to create a secret board.

A secret board allows you to keep your pins hidden from unauthorized participants while planning your bridal shower, so ideas for the party can be kept a secret but still be collaborative.

The first step is to name the board. Be as creative or as simple as you wish when choosing a name.

The next step is to make the board into a secret.

See the button next to the word Secret?

Click on the "No" section and "Yes" should be highlighted in red.

Next, click on the "create" button to activate your board.

That's it, you have successfully blocked your pins from anyone not invited to view the board.

It is officially a well-kept secret!

Now it's your turn.
